Irish for parents.ie

This site has been developed by Gaeloideachas as a resource for parents whose children attend naíonraí and Irish-medium primary schools and also as a resource for teachers who teach Irish language classes for parents. The website is full of helpful learning resources - vocabulary based on relevant topics, video and audio files, as well as information about language structures. There is also support available with homework.

There are many great dictionaries available online. These can be used to find the Irish or English equivalent word while you are reading with your child, helping with homework, playing a game, etc. Some of the dictionaries also provide information about pronunciation, grammar, and usage.
